General Synod Outcome - "The Anglican Church of Aotearoa, New Zealand and Polynesia has decided to table its 'A Way Forward' report on blessings of same-sex couples until General Synod 2018, "with a firm expectation that a decision to move forward will be made" at that time. Archbishop Brown Turei, Archbishop Philip Richardson and Archbishop Winston Halapua will appoint a working group to establish a structure that allows both those who can and cannot support the blessing of same-sex relationships to remain within the church with integrity. The three archbishops made this statement: "We are aware of the considerable pain that this decision will cause to those most affected. "But we are confident that our determination to work together across our differences will bring us to a place of dignity and justice for everyone."
