MOVING IN

We have applied for a CPU for the Community Centre. A CPU is a Certificate for Public Use issued by the Council when it is satisfied the premises are safe for members of the public to use, before a Code of Compliance Certificate is issued. Please pray that the preparations for this will go smoothly and that it will be granted soon.

Stage 1 of the move is to pack as many items as possible during this coming week. On Saturday 14 September we will move the boxes into the hall. We need about 30 Banana boxes with lids to pack up items in the church offices. If you have any could you please drop them into the church on Monday 9 September and stack them near the side door along the wall closest to the office. We also need handymen/women to fix the heavy items of furniture to the walls and do a variety of other jobs. Some of this work can be done on Saturday 14 September.

Stage 2 is to move furniture and equipment to the hall. We will have "A Man and a Van" to move the furniture and heavy items on Monday morning 16 September. We will need to secure the furniture in case of earthquakes once it is in place. This will be done from mid – morning on Monday 16 September. The screws and brackets will be supplied! If ladders or steps are involved we will need to work in pairs for safety.
